Is there a federal tax credit for solar panels?

Eligible homeowners can reduce solar panel installation costs through the federal tax credit, but the program does not guarantee \$8,500 in savings. The Department of Energy has warned the public about scams suggesting otherwise and stated that the federal government has no such programs to fund solar panel installation.

Does the US government buy solar panels?

There is no such program. The U.S. government does not buy solar panels for American homeowners, according to the U.S. Department of Energy.
