Could solar power power China in 2060?

Researchers from Harvard, Tsinghua University in Beijing, Nankai University in Tianjin and Renmin University of China in Beijing have found that solar energy could provide 43.2% of China's electricity demands in 2060at less than two-and-a-half U.S. cents per kilowatt-hour.

#### What is the future of solar energy in China?

China has already made major commitments to transitioning its energy systems towards renewables, especially power generation from solar, wind and hydro sources. However, there are many unknowns about the future of solar energy in China, including its cost, technical feasibility and grid compatibility in the coming decades.

#### How big is China's solar & wind power capacity?

#### Does China have a solar industry?

Today, China has more than 80 percent of the world's solar manufacturing capacity. The extraordinary scale of China's renewables sector output has driven down prices worldwide, and this is a key factor in reducing the cost barrier to renewable systems for poorer countries.
