

What is a photovoltaic mounting system?

Photovoltaic mounting systems (also called solar module racking) are used to fix solar panels on surfaces like roofs, building facades, or the ground. [1 ] These mounting systems generally enable retrofitting of solar panels on roofs or as part of the structure of the building (called BIPV). [2 ]

How do you attach solar panels to a roof?

To attach a solar PV system, you first use rails and mounts made of aluminum. Then, the system is secured to the roof by penetrating the roofing material and securing the system feet using lag bolts. The bolts are sunk into the rafters.

How do I install rigid solar panels on my roof?

EcoFlow's rigid solar panels come with a EcoFlow Tilt Mount Bracket for easy rooftop installation. The components include four fixing brackets, two adjustable brackets, and screws. This should be all you need to mount rigid solar panels on the roof or any other flat surface on your home that receives direct sunlight.
