What does wattage mean on a solar panel?

Generally, they are referring to the wattage, power output, and capacity of a solar panel. Standardized residential solar panels on the market are quoted to generate averagely between 250 and 400 watts an hour. Typical domestic solar panel systems are rated to produce power ranging from 1 KW to 4 KW.

How are solar panels rated?

A solar panel is rated by the amount of direct current (DC) power it generates under standard test conditions. We usually express solar panel output in units of watts (W). And pricing in solar is usually measured in dollars per watt (\$/W), so the total bill of your solar system is determined by the final wattage of your solar panels.
