



Lazy wind curling hair iron style

Can you use a flat iron to curl your hair?

While it sounds counterintuitive, you can use a flat iron to curl your hair- whether you're looking for beachy waves or tight curls. The trick is in the technique.

How do you use a curling iron?

With the hair wrapped around the barrel, pull the iron out to the end of your hair and release. For tighter curls, rotate the irons 360 degrees, so your hair is fully wrapped around. Additionally, the more horizontal you hold the irons, the tighter the curl.

How do you get a tight curl on a curling iron?

For tighter curls, rotate the irons 360 degrees, so your hair is fully wrapped around. Additionally, the more horizontal you hold the irons, the tighter the curl. Finally, the faster you pull through the hair, the looser the curl, so go slow for a tighter result. Repeat your chosen technique on each one-inch section until you're done!

Do rotating curling irons really work?

But, then we discovered rotating curling irons, which literally do the work for you. They're ideal for anyone who needs extra assistance when styling their hair. As the name suggests, rotating curling irons wind your hair up the barrel automatically, creating perfectly uniform, bouncy curls (or waves) with little to no effort.

Does a wand curling iron have a clamp?

A wand curling iron has no clamp. Instead, you wrap your hair around the barrel and hold it in place while the curl forms. Your choice is all based on personal preference and which you find easier to use. Next, think about how curly you want your hair to be.

How do you curl a hair follicle with a curling iron?

1. Grab a section of hair. Create a section of hair to curl. The smaller the section, the tighter the curl. The larger the section, the looser the curl. 2. Position your curling iron. Open the clamp of your iron, then place it toward the root of your section of hair, with the hair placed between the open clamp and the iron.
